Great Turnout for the Fiesta



We had a wonderful turnout for the 2022 Fiesta Fundraiser that was held on September 29 at the Tulare Community Church. Dave Schlick emceed the fundraiser and the dinner was authentic Mexican food from Gaby Galindo and Miguel Morfin, family members of the Escobars. The main purpose of the event was to raise funds for the monthly operating budget for Village of Hope. The upcoming annual operating budget is \$188,844 and it is money well spent. The funds are needed to keep all the ministries going at the Village of Hope, including the feeding programs, after school programs and the pastor's small salaries. This year, the Fiesta raised about \$30,000 in donations, with another \$550 per month in pledges. In addition, one of our supporters raised \$21,000 prior to the banquet. We praise God for everyone's generosity. We know that several of you were not able to attend the banquet, but you still want to donate to Village of Hope. We still need to raise \$131,000 for the operating budget, not to mention several capital improvements that we are raising funds for. Your support is needed and would be greatly appreciated.
